The Moab Arts Festival invites you to exhibit your original artwork at the 28<sup>th</sup> Annual Memorial Day Moab Arts Festival on Saturday, May 28, from 10 - 7 pm, and Sunday, May 29, 2022, from 10 - 6 pm.

The Festival takes place at the Swanny City Park, located on the corner of 400 North and 100 West. Both covered space and outdoor space is available to exhibitors. Spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Our goal is to offer you, the artist and craftsman, an opportunity to display and sell your work in a friendly atmosphere in one of the world's most picturesque settings.

**Beer & Wine Garden.** Moab Brewery and Spanish Valley Vineyards will be offering a wide variety of tasting opportunities to those attending the Moab Arts Festival.

The Festival is promoted through Moab Arts Festival Newspaper, social media, radio, newspaper feature articles, event calendars, posters, and highway signs, attracting numerous visitors to this fun and fabulous event. The Moab Arts Festival continues as a spectacular forum for high-quality fine arts and crafts.

## To Enter

Nonrefundable entry fee covers both days.

Entry fee: 10' x 10' Booths \$300 Covered -\$200 Outdoor  
plus 10% Commission on Sales.

If an exhibitor occupies an outdoor booth, there is no guarantee of a shady spot. Although weather is most often at its best in May, there is always a chance of rain or wind, so we recommend that exhibitors bring some form of protection from the sun, plastic to cover up displays in case of showers. It is very important that you secure your booth and all property from wind. Microbursts are common and unpredictable. Many exhibitors use heavy weights such as sand bags to secure their tent; stakes may be allowed with caution. Sorry, we are unable to refund for bad weather or for cancellations.

A temporary sales tax license will be issued by the Utah State Tax Commission. The sales tax rate in Moab will be **8.85%**. Exhibitors are responsible for reporting sales from this show directly to the Utah State Tax Commission.

A **10% commission** on all sales is part of the entry fee at the 2022 Moab Arts Festival.

This fee is to be paid at the close of the show.

**Pets or overnight camping are not allowed on the premises of the Swanny City Park.**

# Eligibility

Booths are located under large festival tents and outdoors on the grass at Swanny City Park. Each exhibitor must provide his or her display and equipment & must attend the booth. The construction of booths, building material or display space will be left to the imagination and creativity of the artists. Necessary building materials are the responsibility of the vendor – no blue tarps will be allowed as part of your booth. Each booth should display an identifying sign. Vehicles do not qualify as booth space.

- Exhibitors are responsible for setting up and attending to their own booths.
- Booth setup time is from 7 - 10 am both mornings, although booths may be set up on Friday night from 5 - 9 pm. Booths may remain overnight Saturday, but art must be removed. Security will be provided SATURDAY NIGHT ONLY.
- Tear down is 6:00 p.m. Sunday. NO EARLIER. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Booths must be secured from the wind. Stakes and weights ok.
- Moab Arts Festival and the City of Moab are not responsible for damage, theft, loss of artwork or display facilities.
- Assignment of booths will be at the Moab Arts Festival discretion.
- **NO PETS OR OVERNIGHT CAMPING ARE ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES OF SWANNY CITY PARK.**

We cannot guarantee a shady spot. Although weather is most often at its best in May, there is always a chance of rain or wind, so we recommend that exhibitors bring some form of protection from the sun, plastic to cover displays in case of showers. Secure booth and all property from wind. # Insurance

As a standard requirement of all of our show exhibitors, it is necessary for you to provide proof of general liability coverage from an insurance company in good standing with minimum policy limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 in all. If you do not have this coverage in place we have made arrangements for all of our exhibitors to acquire this coverage at significant savings by purchasing as part of a group. # Booth Space

The Moab Arts Festival encourages applications for the display of paintings, drawings, prints, photography, ceramics, sculpture, fibers, jewelry, glass, furniture, wearable art and fine crafts. If you have questions as to whether your art can qualify, please feel free to call our office at 435-259-2742.

**All work by the artist or craftsperson must be their own creative, original concept, design and execution**—no T-shirts unless each is originally hand painted separately. Photographs showing your work need to be submitted with your application or by email. **To submit digital images, attach high resolution jpg or pdf files with your email to [info@moabartsfestival.org](mailto:info@moabartsfestival.org).** Photos will be returned during the event. Items not honestly represented on applications will be removed. All items must be handmade by the exhibitor. No manufactured or imported goods will be allowed. Sorry, no reps. Any artist displaying work of this sort will be asked to leave the Festival without refund of entry fees!

Qualifying applicants will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Up to two applicants may share booth space and must apply together with no extra charge. Each artist must submit three photos of their artwork. Please include a brief biography and statement (100 - 200 words) for use by the Festival for publicity. Artist bios and photographs are included in the Moab Arts Festival Newspaper. Approximately 10,000 copies of this full-color newspaper will be distributed in Moab and Salt Lake City Utah and Grand Junction Colorado, before and during the Arts Festival. Application to the Moab Arts Festival implies the right to use photos and bios for publicity purposes.
